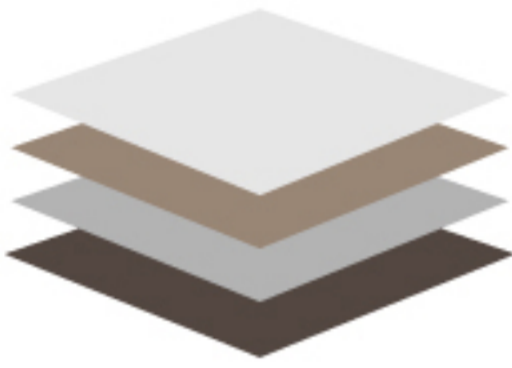


# Answers to Vinyl Flooring FAQs



What is vinyl flooring made of?



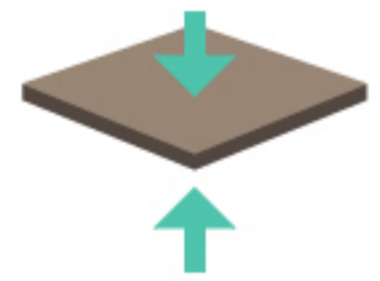
Colored polyvinyl chloride (PVC) chips (a synthetic plastic polymer)

It is constructed by fusing together 4 layers:

- 1. Wear:** Protects floor from fading and stains
- 2. Design:** Photographic image of wood, stone, ceramic tile, or slate
- 3. Inner core:** Plastic resin to keep flooring stable and flat
- 4. Backing:** A moisture barrier protects flooring from warping

How is vinyl tile made?

By forming PVC chips into solid sheets using pressure and heat



How long do vinyl floors last?

**15 to 25 years**
