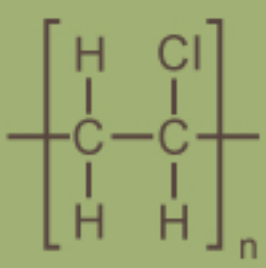
VINYL

-  Locks into place
-  Is eco-friendly
-  Is quiet underfoot with an underlayment pad
-  Is easy to clean
-  Is more durable than hardwood flooring
