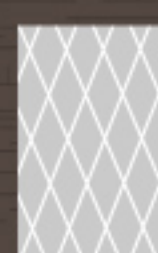


How to Choose the Right Size Area Rug

Thinking of buying an area rug for your space, but unsure of which size to get? Consider this your cheat sheet.

Standard area rug sizes:



3' x 5'



4' x 6'



5' x 8'



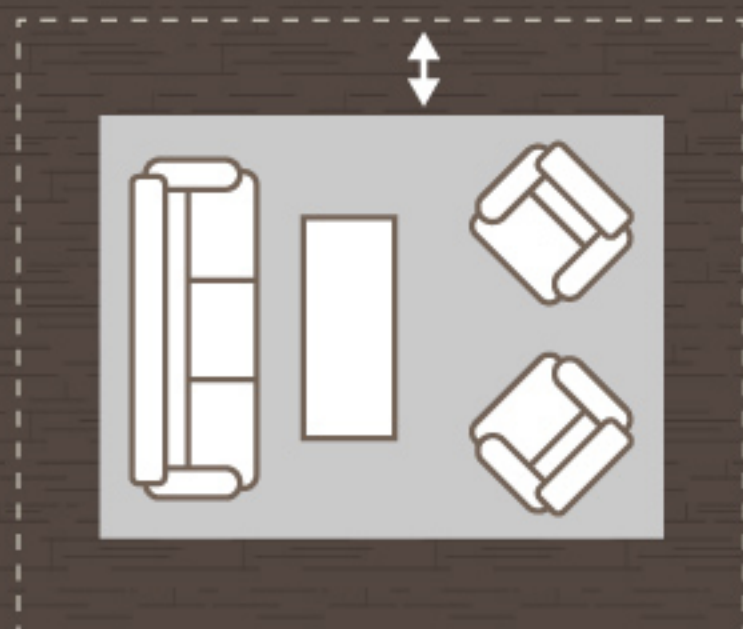
8' x 11'



9' x 12'

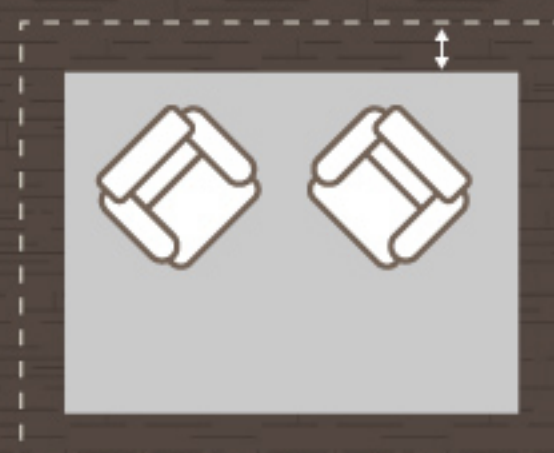
Large rooms should show:

12" to 24" of perimeter floor

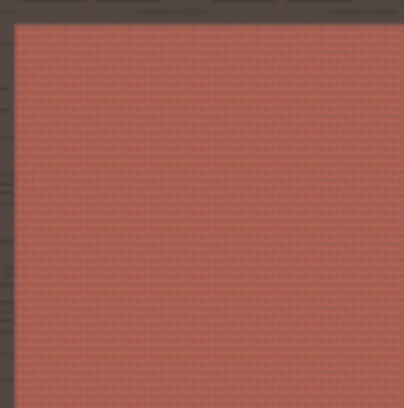


Small rooms should show:

8" to 10" of perimeter floor



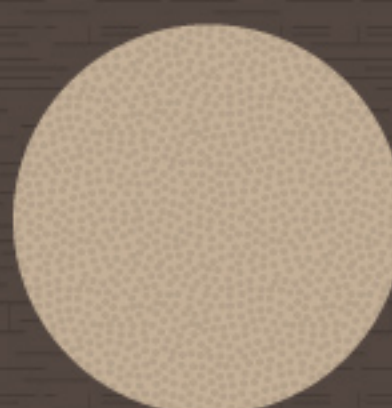
Area rug shapes:



Square



Rectangle

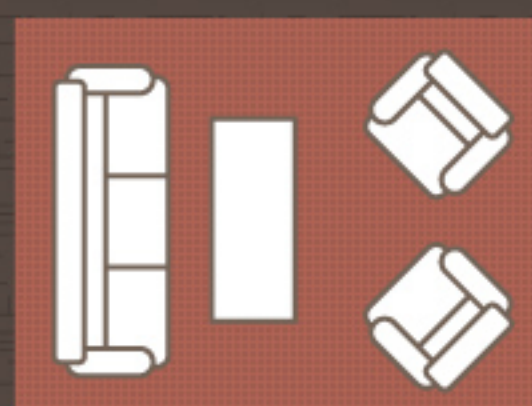


Circle

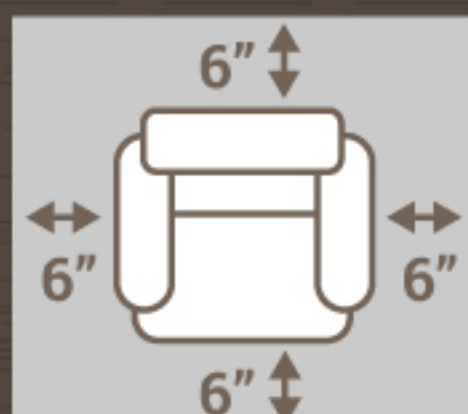


Oval

Area rug sizing tips:



Ensure each piece of furniture touches the rug



Rug should extend 6" past the furniture



Smaller rugs can be used to accent large spaces

Most common area rug sizing mistake:



A rug that is too small
